



# Private Education Programs

The Downeast Lakes Land Trust (DLLT) offers year-round public education programs that build knowledge, appreciation, and respect for the natural and cultural history of the Downeast Lakes region. If your time visiting Grand Lake Stream does not align with our public program schedule, DLLT is pleased to now offer Private Education Programs. DLLT Education and Outreach Manager (EOM), Colin Brown, will present an educational program of your choosing from the topics listed below. The program content can be altered for all ages. Programs are free of charge, but donations to DLLT are greatly appreciated.

Reservations must be made at least 7 days in advance. Private programs will not be scheduled or interfere with regularly scheduled DLLT public programs and events. The specific content of private programs will be at the discretion of the EOM and will not exceed 2 hours in length. The maximum number of participants is 15 and the program must take place in the Grand Lake Stream area. A liability waiver is required for all unaccompanied minors.

## Programs

**Birding** – a short hike to identify and observe birds in the Community Forest.

**Ecology Walk** – a naturalist-led walk that highlights local flora and fauna.

**Owl Pellet Dissection** – DLLT will provide materials and tools for this family-fun activity.

**Survival Skills** – learn fire building, shelter making, wild edibles, and more!

**Introduction to Tracking** – an inquiry into discovering how animals behave by tracking their movements.

**Geocaching** – attempt the Downeast Lakes Geocache Challenge!

**Orienteering** – learn map and compass skills in the Farm Cove Community Forest.

**GLS Scavenger Hunt** – an exploration of Grand Lake Stream!
