Firewood

- DLLT has established a program by which local residents and camp owners may be permitted to obtain a limited quantity of firewood from the Downeast Lakes Community Forest. Firewood may be obtained only by permits to be issued by DLLT. There will be no charge for firewood made available pursuant to this low volume authorization.
- Local residents and camp owners may receive a permit to obtain up to four (4) cords of firewood per household, per calendar year. This wood is for personal use only, and may not be sold or traded.
- In its sole discretion, DLLT will prescribe whether firewood shall be taken from salvage sources or from wood harvested for firewood purposes. In the case of firewood to be harvested, DLLT will specify the kinds and quantities of wood that may be taken, together with the harvest locations, and such other requirements that DLLT may choose to impose.
- Firewood in volumes larger than those available under this permit may be made available subject to commercial arrangements between prospective purchasers and Downeast Lakes Land Trust or contractors designated and supervised by Downeast Lakes Land Trust for that purpose.
