



"Community Conservation" Film Screenings Held Across Maine

Downeast Lakes Land Trust (DLLT) is co-hosting two upcoming screenings of Mark Ireland's documentary film, "Community Conservation: Finding the Balance Between Nature and Culture." After premiering on Maine Public Television in May, the film has received excellent reviews and highlights the



work of four land trusts in Maine: Androscoggin Land Trust, Brunswick-Topsham Land Trust, Rangeley Lakes Heritage Trust, and DLLT.

On **Tuesday, November 21st (Tonight!!)**, Frenchman Bay Conservancy, Maine Coast Heritage Trust, and DLLT are co-hosting a screening at The Grand in Ellsworth. Tickets are free, and the show begins at 7 pm.

On **Tuesday, December 12th**, DLLT and Maine Coast Heritage Trust are co-hosting a screening at Washington County Community College (WCCC) in Calais. Tickets are free, and the show begins at 6 pm.

Following both screenings, there will be an interactive panel discussion of local conservationists, with a question and answer session. December 15 - Christmas Bird Count: Downeast Lakes Land Trust is sponsoring a count circle for the 118th Christmas Bird Count! From December 14 through January 5 each year, tens of thousands of volunteers throughout the Americas brave the winter weather to take part in one of the oldest citizen science projects in the country. Organized by The Audubon Society, Audubon and other organizations use bird data collected in this long-running wildlife census to assess the health of bird populations, and to help guide conservation action.

DLLT's participation date is Friday, December 15th, with most of the count area located in the 55,000-acre Downeast Lakes Community Forest. Head into the community forest and help document the many

species of birds that call the Downeast Lakes region home!
